#### Hover Aid Bike Ride

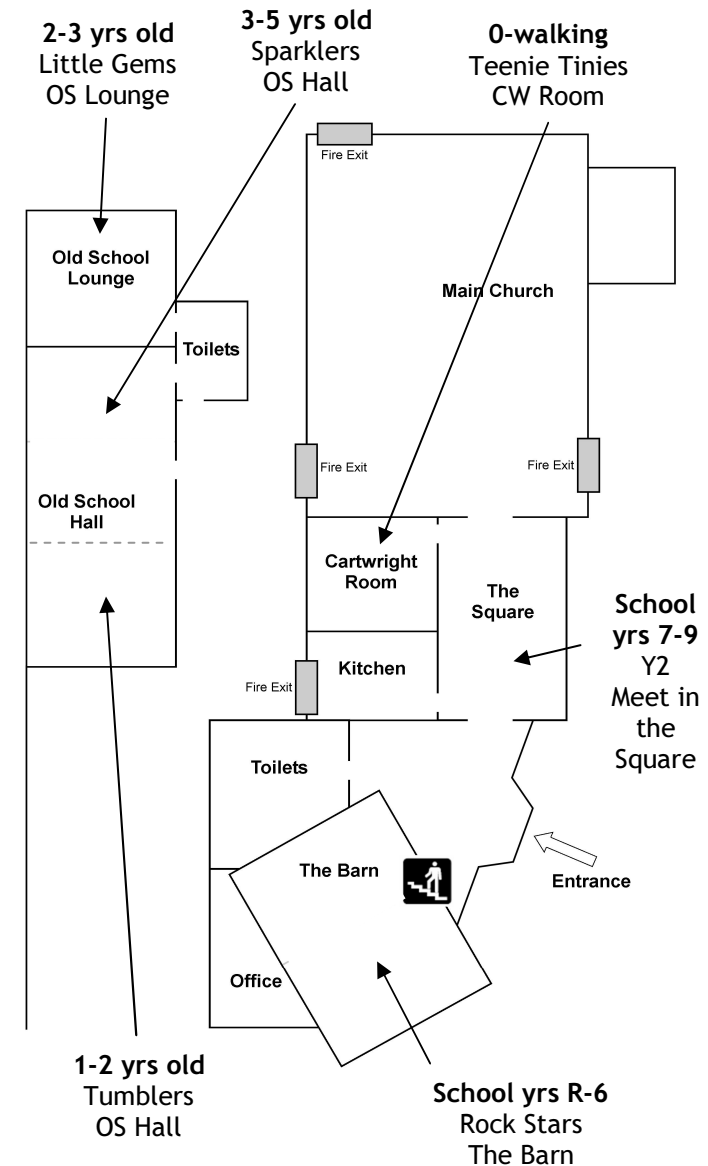
